Brazil / 2016 / Experimental documentary / 04'

Nov. 5, 2015: the collapse of a mining tailing dam spreads 60 million m³ of toxic waste, contaminating 500 kms of land and rivers in Brazil. An experimental documentary about waste decontrol, the leaking of liquefied waste and its consequences. Shot in Mariana 40 days after the disaster.



CÉU DE AGOSTO (AUGUST SKY) by Jasmin Tenucci

Brazil / 2021 / Fiction / 16'

As the Amazon burns for the seventeenth day, a nurse in Sao Paulo finds herself drawn to a neo-Pentecostal church.



PLSTC by Laen Sanches

France / 2022 / Experimental animation / 02'

An underwater dystopia that delves into the disturbing reality of plastic pollution in our oceans. A wake-up call about the devastating consequences of our lifestyle on marine life.



ILHA DAS FLORES (ISLE OF FLOWERS) by Jorge Furtado

Brazil / 1989 / Documentary / 15'

A tomato is planted, picked, sold and ends up in the dump on "Flower Island" among pigs, women and children. The difference between tomatoes, pigs and human beings becomes clear.



SOLEIL GRIS (ASHEN SUN) by Camille Monnier

France, Belgium / 2024 / Animation / 13'

Under a scorching sun, Charlie is bored out of her mind and dreams of going to the seaside. But she's forced to guard a seedy motel with her cousin Jess, who's slumped in her deckchair.



ACIDE (ACID) by Just Philippot France / 2017 / Fiction / 18'

A disturbing cloud has appeared from the west. It moves slowly towards the centre of the country, prompting the population to take to the roads. As it advances relentlessly, panic increases. It is a cloud of acid.
